In Phonics this week we will begin learning the rule- **vc'/cv**; in words with two vowel sounds, we must separate the vowels into syllables before we code them. (Syllable division rule). We will also review combinations (ar, or, er) and get reader # 15, "Eight is the Best Number".

In math we will review cylinders and spheres and work with cones, (one end a circle, one end a point), count by 2's to 100, identify even and odd numbers to 20, and draw pictures to go with story problems.

Midterm letters will be sent home Thursday, May 3. Please sign and return them to school. The letter lists all the skills that the children need to know for final evaluations. It would be helpful for your child if you would copy the "pop-up" (high-frequency) words to practice at home.

In Math we are continuing to position numbers on a place value chart, and we are practicing how to add three single-digit numbers together. We are also identifying geometric solids and using comparison symbols (>, <, =).

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## Safe and Sacred

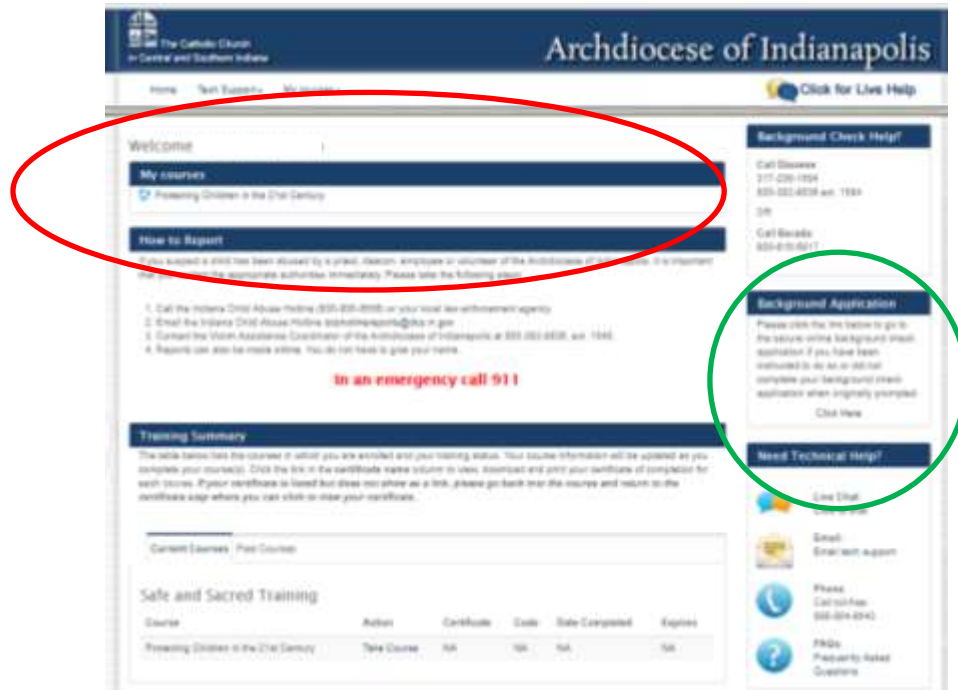
The Archdiocese of Indianapolis is sending out reminders to people that need to take or update training and/or their background check. Your certification will expire every three (3) years. You can either click on the link in the email you receive or you can go to [www.safeandsacred-archindy.org](http://www.safeandsacred-archindy.org). Please see below for a screen shot of what your screen will look like.

### Steps:

Log into your Safe and Sacred account. If you need any assistance with logging in, please contact tech support as directed on the site. You may be asked to update your profile.

1. You will need to take the course (or courses) that are listed under the “My Courses” on the left side of the screen.
2. You will also need to request a background check. You can do this by selecting the “Click Here” under “Background Application”

1. Take the class or classes that are at the top of the page.
2. Go to the right side of the screen and click on the “Click Here” under the Background Application



St. Mary's will receive notification that you have completed the training and in about 1 week, we will receive your background check.
