St. Mary School Biz

Here is an update on the progress and policies I am making in assisting our school/parish at this critical time

1. If a substitute teacher is needed, our 1st attempt will be to fill that need by using our own staff. An example: If the 2nd grade teacher is out for the day; her class will be absorbed by the 3rd grade teacher. This results in no cost.
2. If a teacher is absent for professional reasons, I can have the sub paid for by Title money provided by the state.
3. Any purchases by staff must first come thru my office & I must get permission from Father Steve.
4. I will be attending a meeting with the Archdiocesan Financial Officers on November 1st to **ATTEMPT** to formulate a comprehensive plan to reach financial viability for our school. This "plan" **COULD POSSIBLY** result in positively helping our parish/school. I have been working on plans for our 2019/2020 school year. The financial staff in Indy will examine these plans & make recommendations.
